BERGER, Dr. Philip: Advocated and founded organizations for HIV care, victims of torture, and refugee care; obtained undergraduate degree and MD from University of Manitoba

BIGELOW, Dr. Wilfred: His hypothermia research revolutionized heart surgery and led to the development of the pacemaker; born in Brandon, Manitoba.

CHOCHINOV, **Dr. Harvey**: Shaped the landscape of palliative care around the world; a leading expert in the psychosocial and spiritual impacts of terminal illness; born in Winnipeg; obtained MD and PhD from University of Manitoba.

CHOWN, Dr. Bruce: His work led to the successful treatment of Rh disease, a condition caused by an incompatibility between the blood of a mother and the developing fetus; obtained MD from University of Manitoba and later became Director of Rh Laboratory in Winnipeg.

DHALLA, Dr. Naranjan: Internationally recognized builder of cardiovascular science in Canada; committed to ensuring benefits of scientific knowledge are shared worldwide.

FRIESEN, Dr. Henry: His research on human growth hormone (HGH) allowed successful replacement therapy in HGH-deficient children; obtained MD from University of Manitoba.

GREENBERG, Dr. Cheryl: devoted career to bringing medical knowledge and care to isolated Indigenous populations; Distinguished Professor of the University of Manitoba.

HOGG, Dr. James: Has given 40 years of contributions to the world's understanding of lung disease; obtained MD from University of Manitoba.

HOLLENBERG, Dr. Charles: Actively promoted the growth of scientific medicine at Montreal General Hospital and University of Toronto; obtained MD from University of Manitoba.

MACLENNAN, Dr. David: Did extensive work on calcium channels and pumps, and how mutations in these proteins can cause inherited muscle diseases; studied at University of Manitoba during his undergraduate years.

NAIMARK, Dr. Arnold: Revolutionized University of Manitoba medical programs; obtained MD from University of Manitoba and served as Dean of Medicine from 1971 to 1981 and President of the University of Manitoba from 1981 to 1996.

RONALD, Dr. Allan: Internationally recognized as a trailblazing expert in infectious disease, he has assisted in providing thousands of Africans with antiretroviral therapy and training in HIV care.

SIMONS, Dr. F. Estelle: Founder of Allergy & Clinical Immunology in the Department of Pediatrics, University of Manitoba; internationally renowned for pharmacologic management of allergic diseases, including anaphylaxis and asthma.

WORTON, Dr. Ronald: Identified the dystrophin gene mutation leading to Duchenne muscular dystrophy; obtained MSc from the University of Manitoba.
